John 6:30–31 (The Scriptures)

³⁰ So they said to Him, “What sign then would You do, so that we see and believe You? What would You do?”

³¹ “Our fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, as it has been written, ‘He gave them bread out of the heaven to eat.’ ”

NOTES:

John 6:32–33 (The Scriptures)

³² Therefore יהושע said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, Mosheh did not give you the bread out of the heaven, but My Father gives you the true bread out of the heaven.

³³ “For the bread of Elohim is He who comes down out of the heaven and gives life to the world.”

NOTES:

John 6:34–40 (The Scriptures)

³⁴ So they said to Him, “Master, give us this bread always.”

³⁵ And יהושע said to them, “I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall not get hungry at all, and he who believes in Me shall not get thirsty at all.

³⁶ “But I said to you that you have seen Me, and still do not believe.

³⁷ “All that the Father gives Me shall come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I shall by no means cast out.

³⁸ “Because I have come down out of the heaven, not to do My own desire, but the desire of Him who sent Me.

³⁹ “This is the desire of the Father who sent Me, that all He has given Me I should not lose of it, but should raise it in the last day.

⁴⁰ “And this is the desire of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him should possess everlasting life. And I shall raise him up in the last day.”

NOTES:

John 6:41–47 (The Scriptures)

⁴¹ Therefore the Yehudim were grumbling against Him, because He said, “I am the bread which came down out of the heaven.”

⁴² And they said, “Is not this יהושע, the son of Yosëph, whose father and mother we know? How is it then that He says, ‘I have come down out of the heaven’?”

⁴³ Then יהושע answered and said to them, “Do not grumble with one another.

⁴⁴ “No one is able to come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him. And I shall raise him up in the last day.

⁴⁵ “It has been written in the prophets, ‘And they shall all be taught by יהוה.’ Everyone, then, who has heard from the Father, and learned, comes to Me.

⁴⁶ “Not that anyone has seen the Father, except He who is from Elohim—He has seen the Father.

⁴⁷ “Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in Me possesses everlasting life.

NOTES:

John 6:48–52 (The Scriptures)

⁴⁸ “I am the bread of life.

⁴⁹ “Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness and they died.

⁵⁰ “This is the bread which comes down out of the heaven, so that anyone might eat of it, and not die.

⁵¹ “I am the living bread which came down out of the heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he shall live forever. And indeed, the bread that I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world.”

⁵² The Yehudim, therefore, were striving with one another, saying, “How is this One able to give us *His* flesh to eat?”

NOTES:

John 6:53–60 (The Scriptures)

⁵³ יהושע therefore said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Adāam and drink His blood, you possess no life in yourselves.

⁵⁴ “He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood possesses everlasting life, and I shall raise him up in the last day.

⁵⁵ “For My flesh is truly food, and My blood is truly drink.

⁵⁶ “He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood stays in Me, and I in him.

⁵⁷ “As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, so he who feeds on Me shall live because of Me.

⁵⁸ “This is the bread which came down out of the heaven, not as your fathers ate the manna and died. He who eats this bread shall live forever.”

⁵⁹ He said this in a congregation, teaching in Kephār Naḥum.

⁶⁰ Therefore many of His taught ones having heard, said, “This word is hard, who is able to hear it?”

John 6:61–71 (The Scriptures)

⁶¹ But יהושע knowing within Himself that His taught ones were grumbling about this, said to them, “Does this make you stumble?”

⁶² “What if you see the Son of Adam going up where He was before?”

⁶³ “It is the Spirit that gives life, the flesh does not profit at all. The words that I speak to you are Spirit and are life.

⁶⁴ “But there are some of you who do not believe.” For יהושע knew from the beginning who they were who did not believe, and who would deliver Him up.

⁶⁵ And He said, “Because of this I have said to you that no one is able to come to Me unless it has been given to him by My Father.”

⁶⁶ From then on many of His taught ones withdrew and were not walking with Him any more.

⁶⁷ יהושע therefore said to the twelve, “Do you also wish to go away?”

⁶⁸ Then Shim‘on Kěpha answered Him, “Master, to whom shall we go? You possess words of everlasting life.

⁶⁹ “And we have believed, and we know that You are the Messiah, the Son of the living Elohim.”

⁷⁰ יהושע answered them, “Have I not chosen you, the twelve, and one of you is a devil?”

⁷¹ He was now speaking of Yehudah from Qerioth, *the son* of Shim‘on, for he, one of the twelve, was about to deliver Him up.
