John 7:1-31

John 7:1–2 (The Scriptures)

And after this יהושע was walking in Galil, for He did not wish to walk in Yehudāh, because the Yehudim were seeking to kill Him.

² And the festival of the Yehudim was near, the Festival of Booths.

NOTES:

John 7:3–5 (The Scriptures)

³ So His brothers said to Him, ‘Get away from here and go into Yehudāh, so that Your taught ones also see the works that You are doing.

⁴ “For no one acts in secret while he himself seeks to be known openly. If You do these *works*, show Yourself to the world.”

⁵ For even His brothers did not believe in Him.

NOTES:

John 7:6–10 (The Scriptures)

⁶ יהושע therefore said to them, “My time has not yet come, but your time is always ready.

⁷ “It is impossible for the world to hate you, but it hates Me because I bear witness of it, that its works are wicked.

⁸ “You go up to this festival. I am not yet going up to this festival, for My time has not yet been filled.”

⁹ And having said this to them, He stayed in Galil.

¹⁰ But when His brothers had gone up to the festival, then He also went up, not openly, but as it were in secret.

NOTES:

John 7:11–15 (The Scriptures)

¹¹ The Yehudim, therefore, were seeking Him at the festival, and said, “Where is He?”

¹² And there was much grumbling about Him among the crowd. Some were saying, “He is good,” but others were saying, “No, but He is leading the crowd astray.”

¹³ However, no one spoke openly of Him for fear of the Yehudim.

¹⁴ And about the middle of the festival יהושע went up into the Set-apart Place, and He was teaching.

¹⁵ And the Yehudim were marvelling, saying, “How does this Man know letters, not having learned?”

NOTES:

John 7:16–24 (The Scriptures)

¹⁶ יהושע answered them and said, “My teaching is not Mine, but His who sent Me.

¹⁷ “If anyone desires to do His desire, he shall know concerning the teaching, whether it is from Elohim, or *whether* I speak from Myself.

¹⁸ “He who speaks from himself is seeking his own esteem, but He who seeks the esteem of the One who sent Him is true, and no unrighteousness is in Him.

¹⁹ “Did not Mosheh give you the Torah? Yet not one of you does the Torah! Why do you seek to kill Me?”

²⁰ The crowd answered and said, “You have a demon, who seeks to kill You?”

²¹ יהושע answered and said to them, “I did one work, and you all marvel.

²² “Because of this Mosheh has given you the circumcision—though it is not from Mosheh, but from the fathers—and you circumcise a man on the Sabbath.

²³ “If a man receives circumcision on the Sabbath, so that the Torah of Mosheh should not be broken, are you wroth with Me because I made a man entirely well on the Sabbath?

²⁴ “Do not judge according to appearance, but judge with righteous judgment.”

NOTES:

John 7:25–27 (The Scriptures)

²⁵ Therefore some of them from Yerushalayim said, “Is this not He whom they are seeking to kill?”

²⁶ “And see! He speaks boldly, and they say none at all to Him. Could it be that the rulers truly know that this is truly the Messiah?”

²⁷ “But we know where this One is from. And when the Messiah comes, no one knows where He is from.”

NOTES:

John 7:28–31 (The Scriptures)

²⁸ יהושע therefore cried out in the Set-apart Place, teaching and saying, “You both know Me, and you know where I am from. And I have not come of Myself, but He who sent Me is true, whom you do not know.

²⁹ “But I know Him, because I am from Him, and He sent Me.”

³⁰ So they were seeking to seize Him, but no one laid a hand on Him, because His hour had not yet come.

³¹ And many of the crowd believed in Him, and said, “When the Messiah comes, shall He do more signs than these which this One did?”
